1 SB 1172 Constitutional Amendments

To prohibit placement of proposed constitutional amendments or revision on ballot if it does not alter, amend, or repeal existing article or amendment to constitution, address fundamental right of citizen of state or seek to create, implement or otherwise change basic structure of state government as determined by Florida Supreme Court. This DID NOT pass the House *We supported.*

2 SB 2082 Grieving Parents

Provided that when a health practitioner or facility has custody of fetal remains following a spontaneous death, the doctor must notify the mother of her option of a burial or a cremation of the child's remains. Passed House and Senate. *We supported.*

3 SB 1490 Expanded Gambling Card Rooms

Expanded Gambling for large casino gambling card rooms in pari-mutuals. This DID NOT pass the House and did not become law. *We opposed.*

4 CSSB 480 Commission on Marriage and Family

Created a commission on Marriage and Family to support initiatives within Children Family Services Dept. Will work with other organizations to promote responsible fatherhood and community based programs. This Passed the House and Senate and became law. *We supported.*

5 CSSB 2062 Military Family Non-Profit Scholarship Funding

Provides Scholarship Funding Tax Credits for military families to be used for dependent children of military personnel. This died in House Messages and DID NOT pass the House and did not become law. *We supported.*

Florida House OF REPRESENTATIVES

- 1 **HB 285 Human Cloning Ban Weakening Amendment**
Human Cloning Prohibition Act weakening amendment to allow "therapeutic" cloning. Representative Jim Kallinger, the bill's sponsor, as well as Reps. Don Brown and Dennis Baxley debated well against the amendment, which still passed 62-51. House Leadership allowed the bill to die after the amendment was added. *We opposed.*
- 2 **HB 89 Grieving Parents Act**
Provided that when a health practitioner or facility has custody of fetal remains following a spontaneous death, the doctor must notify the mother of her option of a burial or a cremation of the child's remains. Passed House and Senate. *We supported.*
- 3 **HB 707 Unborn Quick Child/Homicide**
This bill was to provide in the event of a death of a viable unborn child by DUI manslaughter a criminal offense. The killing of the child would be considered vehicular homicide provided that killing of the child by injury to the mother which would be murder in any degree if it resulted in the death of the mother is murder in the same degree and would be prosecutable as such. This bill DID NOT pass the Senate and did not become law. *We supported.*

- 4 **HB 137 Resident Tax Relief**
Would have provided tax free days for school supplies, books and clothing. This bill DID NOT pass the Senate and did not become law. *We supported.*
- 5 **HB 415 Library Filters**
Requiring public libraries to install and maintain computer software or equivalent technology that would prohibit access to obscene materials to minors. This bill DID NOT pass the Senate and did not become law. *We supported.*
- 6 **CSSB 480 Commission of Marriage and Family**
Created a commission on Marriage and Family to support initiatives within Children Family Services Dept. Will work with other organizations to promote responsible fatherhood and community based programs. This Passed the House and Senate and became law. *We supported.*
