House Bill Descriptions

1. Commission on Marriage & Family (CSSB 480)

Would create Commission on Marriage & Family Support Initiatives within the Department of Children and Families. (Passed) - Supported

2. Internet Filtering (H415)

Requiring public libraries to install & maintain computer software or equivalent technology that would prohibit access to obscene materials to minors. (Failed) - Supported

3. Tax Holiday (H137)

Would have provided tax free days for school supplies, books and clothing (Failed) - Supported

4. Unborn Child Homicide (H707)

This bill was to provide in the event of a death of a viable unborn child by DUI manslaughter a criminal offense. The killing of the child would be considered vehicular homicide. Provided that killing of the child by injury to the mother which would be murder in any degree if it resulted in the death of the mother is murder in the same degree and would be prosecutable as such. (Failed) - Supported

5. Grieving Parents Rights Act (H89)

Provided that when a health practitioner or facility has custody of fetal remains following a spontaneous death, the doctor must notify the mother of her option of a burial or a cremation of the child's remains. (Passed) - Supported

6. Human Cloning Prohibition Act (H285)

Weakening amendment to allow "therapeutic" cloning. Representative Jim Kallinger, the bill's sponsor, as well as Reps. Don Brown and Dennis Baxley debated well against the amendment, which still passed 62-51. (Failed) - Opposed

7. Special Session Vote on Terri's Law (H35E)

This Bill granted the Governor a one-time stay from the removal of nutrition and hydration from Terri Schiavo. (Passed) - Supported

8. 2nd Floor Vote On Fiscal Impact of Constitutional Amendment Bill

Requires that the fiscal impact of implementing a constitutional amendment to be listed on the ballot along with the summary. (Passed) - Supported

9. House Vote On Fiscal Impact of Constitutional Amendment Bill (H1743)

Requires that the fiscal impact of implementing a constitutional amendment to be listed on the ballot along with the summary. (Passed) - Supported

10. Parental Rights Amendment Committee Vote (H159)

Constitutional Amendment to limit a minors right to privacy and to limit any other state provision limiting the authority of parents in relation to their children. Passed committee but died afterwards.

(Failed) - Supported

11. Middle Grades Reform Act House Education Committee Vote (H901)

Would create more rigorous academic requirements for middle grades, to include reading and writing. (Failed) - Supported

12. Parental Notification of a minor seeking an abortion (HJR1)

Will create a constitutional amendment allowing for legislation that would require a minor to notify their parent before having an abortion

(Passed) - Supported

13. Proposed Amendment to Parental Notification (HJR1)

Suggested amendment that would have nullified the purpose of parental notification bill by allowing for a minor to choose whether or not to tell their parents.

(Failed) - Opposed

14. Final Vote on HJR1 After Senate Modification

House final vote on the Senate modifications to the Parental Notification Amendment.

(Passed) - Supported

1. Military Family Non-Profit Scholarship Funding (S2062)

Provides Scholarship Funding Tax Credits for military families to be used for dependent children of military personnel. (Failed) - Supported

2. Commission on Marriage and Family (S480)

Created a commission on Marriage and Family to support initiatives within Children Family Services Dept. Will work with other organizations to promote responsible fatherhood and community based programs. (Failed) - Supported

3. Constitutional Amendments (S1172)

To prohibit placement of proposed constitutional amendments or revision on ballot if it does not alter, amend, or repeal existing article or amendment to constitution, address fundamental right of citizen of state or seek to create, implement or otherwise. (Failed) - Supported

4. Pari-mutuel Wagering (S1490)

Expanded Gambling for large casino gambling card rooms in pari-mutuals. (Failed) - Opposed

5. Saboor Grieving Parents Act (S2082)

Provided that when a health practitioner or facility has custody of fetal remains following a spontaneous death, the doctor must notify the mother of her option of a burial or a cremation of the child's remains. (Passed) - Supported

6. Terri's Bill (H35E)

This Bill granted the Governor a one-time stay from the removal of nutrition and hydration from Terri Schiavo. (Passed) - Supported

7. Parental Notification Amendment (H1S)

Senate Vote on the Parental Notification Amendment after it passed the house the first time. Requires a parent of a minor seeking an abortion to be notified. (Passed) - Supported

8. Cardrooms (S1086)

Authorizes cardroom operators to host high-stakes poker tournaments at certain pari-mutuel facilities. (Failed) - Opposed

9. Library Internet Filter Governmental Oversight and Productivity Committee (S1552)

Committee Vote on legislation requiring public libraries to provide technology that blocks or filters Internet access to pornographic or obscene materials. (Failed) - Supported

10. Library Internet Filter Public Utilities Committee Vote (S1552)

Committee Vote on legislation requiring public libraries to provide technology that blocks or filters Internet access to pornographic or obscene materials. (Failed) - Supported

11. Health Care Licensing Procedures Act (S1680)

Requires abortion clinics to be in compliance (Failed) - Supported

12. Instant Bingo (S1940)

Defines terms "instant bingo" & "deal" and provides rules for operation of instant bingo games. (Failed) - Opposed

13. Adoption (S2046)

Restricts the ability of DCF to remove children from foster home under certain circumstances; Provides exemption to rule that department approval be attached to adoption petition. (Passed) - Supported

14. Judiciary Committee Vote on Parental Notification (Senate Version) (S2178)

Allows Legislature to create legislation that would provide for parental notification for a minor seeking an abortion. (Failed) - Supported

15. Health, Aging, and Long Term Care Committee Vote Parental Notification (Senate Version) (S2178)

Allows Legislature to create legislation that would provide for parental notification for a minor seeking an abortion. (Failed) - Supported

16. Penny-Ante Games (S2474)

The bill provides an exemption to the prohibition on solicitation of participants by means of advertising for penny-ante games by allowing the posting of a notice at the dwelling or distributing notice to residents or member of the entity owning the dwelling. (Failed) - Opposed
