Proposed Amendments to Florida's Constitution

Amendment One:

If you would like to establish a long-range budget-planning process, create a Government Efficiency Task Force to seek input from the public, and create a long-range financial plan, then vote "Yes"

Amendment Three:

If you would like to prevent an increase in the number of votes needed to approve a ballot initiative from 50% +1 to 60% +1 of those voting on a measure, then vote "No"

Amendment Six:

If you would like to authorize the Legislature to allow counties to increase the maximum additional homestead exemption for low-income seniors by \$25,000, then vote "Yes"

Amendment Seven:

If you would like to lower taxes for certain disabled veterans, allowing them to take a discount on their homestead property tax equal in proportion to the amount of their disability, then vote "Yes"

Amendment Eight:

If you would like to limit eminent domain by requiring seized private property to be retained for 10 years before it may be transferred to another private entity, then vote "Yes"
