**Read Together:**

If then the light that is in you is darkness, how great is the darkness! <sup>24</sup> “No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth.”

**Talk Together:**
