READ TOGETHER Matthew 25:14-30

Matthew 25:14-15 ¹⁴ "For it is just like a man about to go on a journey, who called his own slaves and entrusted his possessions to them. ¹⁵ To one he gave five talents, to another, two, and to another, one, each according to his own ability; and he went on his journey.

Matthew 25:19-21 ¹⁹ "Now after a long time the master of those slaves came and settled accounts with them. ²⁰ The one who had received the five talents came up and brought five more talents, saying, 'Master, you entrusted five talents to me. See, I have gained five more talents.' ²¹ His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful slave. You were faithful with a few things, I will put you in charge of many things; enter into the joy of your master.'

Matthew 25:24-26, 30 ²⁴ "And the one also who had received the one talent came up and said, 'Master, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you did not sow and gathering where you scattered no seed. ²⁵ And I was afraid and went away and hid your talent in the ground. See, you have what is yours.' ²⁶ "But his master answered and said to him, 'You wicked, lazy slave, you knew that I reap where I did not sow and gather where I scattered no seed. ³⁰ Throw out the worthless slave into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

TALK TOGETHER.

- I. Who do the master and the three servants represent? What does this teach us about our relationship with God?
- 2. What differentiates the reaction of the servant with one talent from the others?
- 3. Why do you think the third servant was called wicked?
- 4. What kind of things has God entrusted to us? Who is the owner of these things? How then should we use them?

CONVICTION

I will be faithful in being a steward of the time, money, and relationships $\operatorname{\mathsf{God}}$ entrusted to $\operatorname{\mathsf{me}}$.

APPLICATION

How are you using the things God has entrusted you for His glory? How else can you show your faithfulness in serving Christ?
