



Religious affiliation, by year of survey






# Christian extinction

# The 25% Revolution—How Big Does a Minority Have to Be to Reshape Society?

A committed few can influence the many and sweep away social conventions, new research shows

“This is not about a small elite with disproportionate resources,” says Arnout van de Rijt, a sociologist at Utrecht University in the Netherlands who studies social networks and collective action, and was not involved in the study. “It's not about the Koch brothers influencing American public opinion. *Rather, this is about a minority trying to change the status quo, and succeeding by being unrelenting. By committing to a new behavior (Christ-likeness), they repeatedly expose others to that new behavior until they start to copy it.*”

# MANY of us are NOT YET DISCIPLES? Only 3 out of 10 CCF members are! WHY?

1. Many have **UNCLEAR** understanding of Disciple Making or being a DISCIPLER.
2. It is **NOT IMPORTANT** to us personally to find time to do it (though it is to our church leaders); it can wait
3. It is not yet our **CONVICTION**; *it is* just a 'belief'
4. We do not really know **HOW TO** do it to practice it to pass it on.

# WHAT A DISCIPLER IS NOT

1. It is **NOT** being part of CCF and attending Worship Service once a week.
2. It is **NOT** being part of a D-group or being busy in a Ministry
3. It is **NOT JUST** leading a D-group.
4. It is **NOT JUST** getting a GLC graduate certificate or even seminary training.

**A DISCIPLER is an *INTENTIONAL* Disciple Maker**  
**What makes Making Disciples**

# Webster defines **INTENTIONAL** as ...

*adjective*

1. done with intention or on ***purpose***;  
intended e.g. *an intentional insult.*

2. of or relating to intention or ***purpose***.

**INTENTIONAL** is always connected with & related to  
**PURPOSE**




And **PURPOSE** according to WEBSTER is ...

*noun*

1. the *reason for which something exists* or is done, made, used, etc.
2. an intended or desired **result; end; aim; goal**.
3. determination; resoluteness.

So, for Disciple Making to be **INTENTIONAL**, it must relate to the **PURPOSE** of disciple making ...

What happens when one is used for purposes other than what it is created for?  
**DAMAGED** & **DESTROYED** , right?!

So, for Disciple Making to be **INTENTIONAL**, it must relate to it's **PURPOSE** ... and that is ...

# Matthew 28:19-20

Go therefore and make disciples  
*(mathētēs: a committed learner, follower of Christ who is like Christ)*  
of all the nations, baptizing them **(SAVED)** in the name of the Father  
and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I  
commanded you **(TRANSFORMED)** and lo, I am with you always,  
even to the end of the age.”`

*Per the Great Commission the **END PRODUCT**  
must be **DISCIPLES** ...*

*who are **SAVED** (baptized) and who **OBEY ALL** the  
commands (transformed) of Christ to be  
**CHRISTLIKE***

Because **CHRISTLIKENESS** is God's  
predestinating **PURPOSE** for saving us ...

Romans 8:29 For those whom He foreknew  
**(*SAVED*)** , He also predestined *to*  
***become conformed to the image of His Son***, so  
that He would be the firstborn among many  
brethren;

## Be Like Christ

**2** Therefore if there is any encouragement in [Christ](#), if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any <sup>[a]</sup>affection and compassion, **2** make my joy complete <sup>[b]</sup>by being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose. **3** Do nothing <sup>[c]</sup>from <sup>[d]</sup>selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves; **4** do not *merely* look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others. **5** Have this attitude <sup>[e]</sup>in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, **6** who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be <sup>[f]</sup>grasped, **7** but <sup>[g]</sup>emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men. **8** Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death <sup>[h]</sup>on a cross. **9** For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, **10** so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, **11** and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

**OBEDIENT** to death







  - Make them Disciple their FAMILIES first (**Join Confide**)
2. As they Disciple their Families, assure them that they will experience God's presence & power to have **CREDIBILITY** in their Lives!
3. Then Watch & SEE the plentiful harvest come to our small groups to exponentially grow our movement to be **MILLIONS**
